and high schoolers through an organization called **Group Work camps**. Spaces are filling up quickly, so I need to know as soon as possible whether or not your child will be attending. The cost is \$229/per person You pay: \$76.34 -- the church budget and our fundraising efforts will pay the rest.

This cost includes all meals and lodging for the trip. The only other money your child should bring is money to buy snacks on

*Sunday School is Cool!*



Following our pilgrims footsteps, Holy Island, Hadrian's Wall, St Paul's Monastery and Durham cathedral.

The monastery of **Lindisfarne** was founded by Irish born Saint Aidan, around AD 635. It became the base for Christian evangelising in the North of England. Northumberland's patron saint, Saint Cuthbert, was a monk and later Abbot of the monastery, and his miracles and life are recorded by the Venerable Bede. Cuthbert later became Bishop of Lindisfarne.

At some point in the early 700s the famous illuminated manuscript known as the Lindisfarne Gospels, an il-

lustrated Latin copy of the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, was made probably at Lindisfarne and the artist was possibly Eadfrith, who later became Bishop of Lindisfarne. Sometime in the second half of the tenth century a monk named Aldred added an Anglo-Saxon (Old English) gloss to the Latin text, producing the earliest surviving Old English copies of the Gospels. Viking raids in 875 led to the monks fleeing the island with St Cuthbert's bones (The bones of St Cuthbert are now buried at the Cathedral in Durham).

### Lindisfarne Gospels

The bishopric was transferred to Durham in AD 1000. The Lindisfarne Gospels now reside in the British Library in London, somewhat to the annoyance of some Northumbrians. The priory was re-established in Norman times in 1093 as a Benedictine house and continued until its suppression in 1536 under Henry VIII. A causeway connects the island to the mainland of Northumberland and is flooded twice a day by tides
